- 14. **PLEASE ADHERE TO YOUR SECTION'S TIME LIMIT FOR YOUR PERFORMANCE.** As a courtesy, all contestants must arrive at the beginning of their Section and not leave until that Section is completed and the Adjudicators have delivered their decision.
- 15. **NO PROMPTING OR ASSISTANCE** of any kind will be permitted, except by the Adjudicator.
- 16. The Committee reserves the right to amend the program at any time and alter any of the Rules and Conditions without notice.

17. THE COMMITTEE'S DECISION IN ALL MATTERS IS FINAL.

- 18. The Committee does not accept any responsibility for music not collected immediately after a Section finishes.
- 19. **DRESS**: Participants are required to dress appropriately for both the Heats and Finals Concert (if selected).
- 20. **ALL PARTICIPANTS** will be notified by both phone and email as to whether or not they will be performing in the Finals Concert. Heat winners should note that they may not necessarily be selected to appear in the Finals Concert. Those who <u>are</u> selected for the Finals Concert will be required to attend the lighting and sound check earlier on that day (time to be advised).
- 21. **ALL MAJOR PRIZE WINNERS** are expected to attend the Finals Concert in order to be presented with their prizes.

B'NAI B'RITH VICTORIA \$1,000 GRAND PRIZE

Potential Grand Prize finalists will be nominated by the Adjudicators. The successful \$1,000 Grand Prize winner will be named at the end of the Finals Concert.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. a) This competition is open to **JEWISH AMATEURS** only. An amateur is one who does not derive income from the art in which he or she is entering.
 - b) B'nai B'rith accepts in good faith, an entry from a contestant who declares himself or herself to be of the Jewish faith.
- 2. a) Entries close on Thursday, 14th June 2018. No entry fee will be refunded unless a Section is cancelled.
 - b) Previous B'nai B'rith major award winners may not enter this competition in a Section in which they have previously won. However, they are welcome to enter other Sections.
 - c) All entry forms must be accompanied by payment/proof of payment, via cheque, bank deposit receipt or copy of internet bank transfer. Remember to attach the consent form to the application.
- 3. **REFUSAL:** The Committee reserves the right to **refuse any entry and to cancel** any Section in which there are fewer than three (3) entries in the Section.
- 4. **AGE LIMIT**: In all Sections, the age of the entrant on 1st August, 2018 shall be deemed to be his or her age.
- 5. **ADJUDICATORS**: Communication with the Adjudicators by competitors, teachers or interested parties prior to, or during the competition is prohibited.
- 6. The Adjudicators reserve the right to withhold any prize where sufficient merit has not been displayed.
- 7. Each Section must have a minimum of three (3) entries to make it viable. Any Section with fewer than three (3) entries may be cancelled and the entry fee will be refunded.
- 8. The Adjudicators shall determine the entrants who will participate in the Finals Concert.
- 9. In the event of a competitor entering more than one Section, different items must be performed on each occasion.
- 10. <u>NOTE:</u> During Heats, a copy of each performance piece <u>must</u> be handed to the Adjudicator <u>and</u> Accompanist prior to the performance.
- 11. BACKING RECORDINGS AND MICROPHONES <u>WILL NOT BE</u> <u>PERMITTED</u> DURING THE HEATS. Unless performing acapella, accompanists are mandatory, whether you decide on the Official Accompanist or one of your own choice.
- 12. ALL ADJUDICATORS' DECISIONS SHALL BE FINAL.
- 13. No one other than the competitor and Accompanist will be allowed on stage, unless approved by the Accompanist or Adjudicator.

PROPOSED PROGRAM ARRANGEMENTS

FINAL ARRANGEMENTS WILL DEPEND ON THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES RECEIVED.

PLEASE ENTER EARLY TO ENSURE SECTIONS ARE VIABLE.

Entry fees are \$15 per Section (not per item) and are non-refundable unless the Section is cancelled.
